Andy Bragen, a lifelong resident of Manhattan's Lower East Side, has received Workspace and Process Space Residencies from the Lower Manhattan Cultural Council. Other honors include the Clubbed Thumb Biennial Commission, a Tennessee Williams Fellowship from Sewanee, and a Jerome Fellowship. His play "This Is My Office" was produced in the autumn of 2013 by The Play Company. Other plays and translations have been produced and/or presented at numerous theatres across the country, including The Guthrie, The Goodman, PS122, The Playwrights Center, Queens Theatre in the Park, EST, Brown/Trinity Playwrights Rep, Studio Roanoke, The University of Rochester, and Soho Rep. Andy collaborates frequently with the jazz saxophonist John Ellis. Their most recent piece, *Mobro*, a chamber piece for nine musicians and four singers was commissioned by and performed at New York's Jazz Gallery in 2011, and featured on WNYC radio's Soundcheck. The studio recording is available on Parade Light Records.
